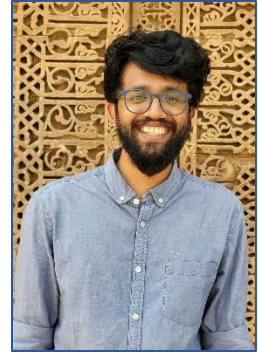


Sangeeth Mathew Philip,

Mr. Sangeeth cleared the UGC-NET in 2019 and the UGC-JRF for Economics in 2022. His research area is primarily focused on gender, development and institutions, focusing on India, from grassroots contexts to macro-level development patterns. Sangeeth's PhD thesis has been submitted for evaluation by the Central University of Rajasthan and is awaiting his doctoral defence. His thesis examines how community-based organisations enhance capability-driven empowerment of women, taking Kudumbashree in Kerala as the central focus. The study explores the macro aspect of empowerment using the National Family Health Survey data of India and then moves to the micro aspect, focusing on Kerala.

Sangeeth has published papers related to his research area in Scopus-indexed journals and peer-reviewed journals and served as a reviewer for a Scopus-indexed journal. He has also published book chapters in edited books and presented his papers at National and International conferences. His areas of teaching interest range from Development Economics, Gender Economics, Microeconomics, Public Economics, Mathematical Economics and Managerial Economics.
