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
ORIENTATION SESSION Semester – III B.Ed Batch 2021-23




National webinar on "HINDI DIWAS"











INTERNATIONAL DAY OF DEMOCRACY

September 15, 2022



<u>Faculty Development Programme in Role of Blooms Taxonomy in nurturing Divergent Thinking in Teaching Learning Process</u>



An FDP was organized by ICFAI Education School on 2nd November 2022 on Blooms Taxonomy and its role in nurturing Divergent Thinking in Teaching Learning Process.

There were 47 participants which included 23 teachers from different schools of Dehradun, Ram nagar and adjoining areas. The Internal Faculty from ICFAI Law School and ICFAI Tech School also attended the FDP.

The Vice Chancellor, Prof (Dr.) Ram Karan Singh in his address stressed on the importance of Bloom's Taxonomy and how it was a major thrust area of NEP 2020. The Registrar of ICFAI University Brig, Rajiv Sethi very categorically explained the need for training the teachers in a manner in which they are successful in inculcating divergent thinking and creativity among the students they teach.

The first session was conducted by the Dean of ICFAI Education School Dr. Meena Bhandari. It was an enthusiastic presentation of 2 hours in which she dealt with NEP 2020 vision, The Role of Bloom's Taxonomy in effective Teaching learning Process, Teaching Objectives and Learning Outcome.



CORPORATE SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY

Visit to Suddhowala Prison

As part of Corporate Social Responsibility, The ICFAI University, Dehradun initiated to donate books to the inmates of the Suddhowala Prison on 6th October 2022. A total of 511 books from diverse areas including engineering, management education spiritual and moral literature also some stationary kits was also donated.

Those present on the occasion were the Vice Chancellor of The ICFAI University, Dehradun, Dr. Ram Karan Singh, Registrar Brigadier Rajiv Sethi, Dr. Meena Bhandari, Dr. Mukul Jain and Ms. Manasvee a MSc. Psychology student.

The Jailor Mr. Pawan Kumar Kothari, welcomed the guests and personally took them around for a visit to various departments, workshop and crafts areas of the jail. He explained in detail all the reformative measures taken to ensure that the inmates were engaged in using their time constructively along with acquiring various job oriented skills in order to make them future ready. There were about 1560 inmates in the prison. The Vice Chancellor proposed to the jailor that the University would organize training and counselling sessions for the inmates to improve their mental health along with organizing legal counselling sessions. This was readily approved by the jailor. The visit to the jail was an experience of a different kind and a grim reminder how it deprives one of his/her personal security. It was a different world altogether how imprisonment can take a huge toll on the mental well-being of inmates. The primary evident psychological effects were self -condemnation guilt and boredom resulting in losses of perspective and of self-confidence. Those who have been incarcerated are tasked to cope with the length of their sentences, separation from their loved ones, as well as the stressors of a prison environment, the primary being 50 inmates were lodged in a single barrack irrespective of their past status in the society. The juvenile prison cell presented a very gloomy picture with more than 50 inmates (aged 15-18 years) sitting together in a small barrack appearing to be totally lost.

The Registrar proposed for a visit to the prison by the University students which was accepted by the jail authorities.
