# Brief Report on Screening of Satyamev Jayate Episode 10 on Untouchability

**Date:** 7th July 2025

**Organized by:** Anti-Discrimination Committee, The ICFAI University, Dehradun

**Participants:** B.Ed. Students

As part of sensitization and awareness activities under the AntiDiscrimination Committee, a special screening of Satyamev Jayate Season 1, Episode 10 on "Untouchability" was conducted on 7th July 2025 for the B.Ed. Students of ICFAI Education School. The session was facilitated by Ms. Swati Raturi, who guided students through a reflective viewing and discussion experience. The episode, hosted by Aamir Khan, powerfully showcased real-life stories and systemic discrimination faced by individuals due to caste-based untouchability, even in contemporary India. The screening aimed to foster empathy, critical thinking,

and a strong understanding of constitutional values among future educators. Following the screening, an interactive discussion was held where students shared their reflections, related incidents, and insights. Ms. Swati Raturi highlighted the legal, ethical, and moral responsibilities of teachers in promoting inclusive education and upholding the principles of equality and dignity for all. The session concluded with a collective commitment by students to become change agents who will challenge discriminatory practices and foster inclusive and respectful classrooms.

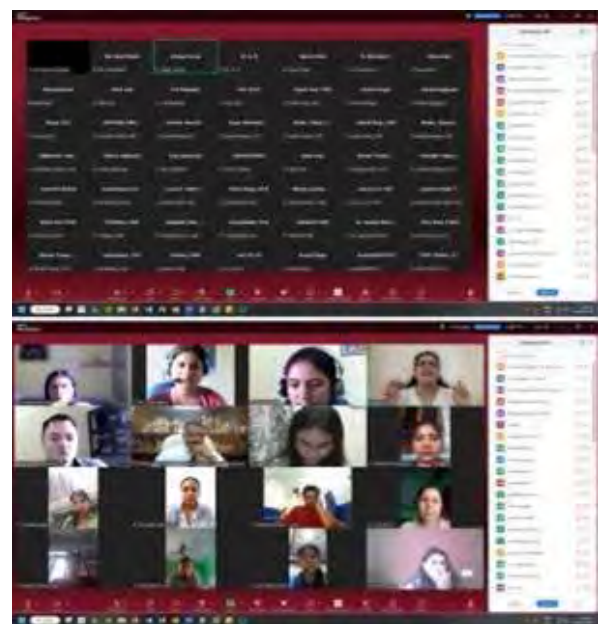

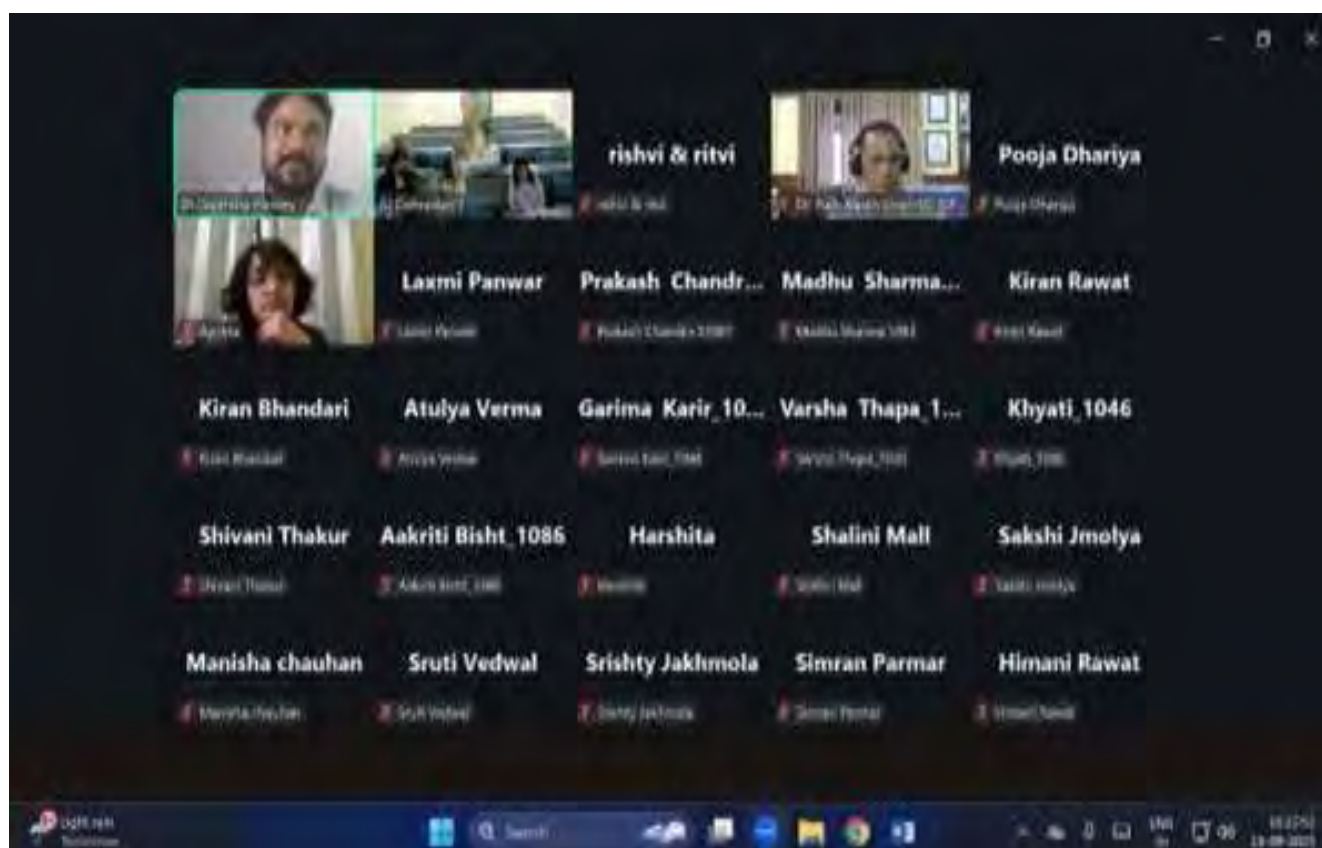

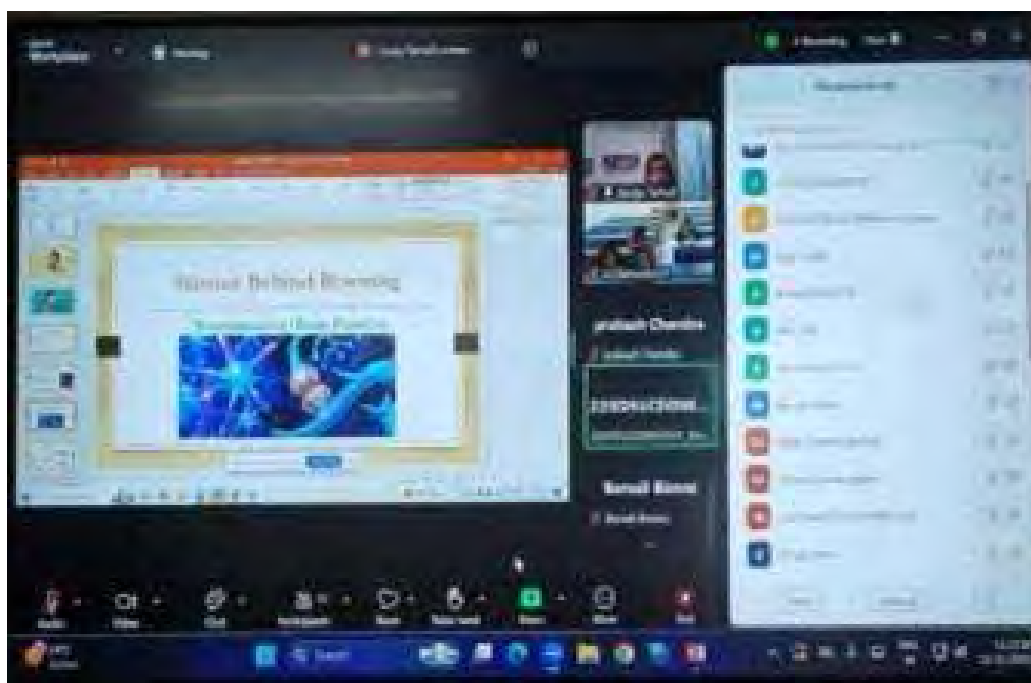

The two-day practicum was designed to bridge the gap between pedagogical theory and classroom practice. B.Ed. trainees conducted teaching sessions in their respective pedagogy subjects, employing activity-based learning strategies, demonstrations, questioning techniques, and ICT-enabled teaching methods. A wide range of Teaching-Learning Materials (TLMs) such as charts, models, flashcards, globes, and low-cost instructional aids were effectively used to enhance learner engagement and conceptual clarity. Throughout both days, the teaching performance of the B.Ed. trainees was systematically evaluated by an External Examiner across both pedagogy subjects.
