## 36.03 Follow up Action on the Minutes of the 35<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Board of Governors

**36.03.01 Polytechnic Principal meet:** It was informed that the Principals of Polytechnic College's meet will be conducted in Oct2016. The Board suggested that the agenda for the meet should also include holding of FDPs, Collaboration for assistance in Technical education.

36.03.02 Integrated MBA. On the proposal for starting of BBA MBA Integrated 4

- year program, the Board suggested checking from UGC about provisions for running such program.
- **36.03.03 Disabled friendly campus** Chancellor suggested that legislative provisions regarding facilities for physically challenged persons related to University premises need to be complied with. It was also suggested that the necessary work should be taken up on priority.

36.03.04: Admissions-It was informed that there has been overall increase in No. of admissions in all UG/PG Programs except B.Tech. The Board suggested that efforts to be made to increase the intake for B.Tech & B.Ed students for the next academic year.	In order to have an entry into schools to address the 10+2 level students, and to motivate the students to take admission at the ICFAI University-Dehradun, we planned a two-stage NJY Memorial Science Quiz and Model National Competition during November 11-12, 2016. At the first stage, faculty visited 145 schools, conducted quiz at the schools, made presentations about ICFAI University, and identified top six students who would participate in the final completion at the ICFAI University campus, Dehradun. In this process, we were able to address about 2943 students.  In the second stage, 145 students, representing 25 schools, participated in the competition at IUD and won trophies and cash prizes.
<b>36.03.05: Research Grant-</b> , Board advised that faculty members should be ready with project proposals for submission to funding agencies and the progress be monitored closely.	IUD is in the process of signing MoUs with Government institutions for resource sharing & conducting joint projects.

The University has planned quarterly News Letter (IUD-Chronicle), both e and print versions, which would report on the activities at all the Schools of the University. The first such issue is scheduled to be out by end January 2017.
36.03.07: NAAC Readiness - The Board reviewed the report presented by Prof. T.S.R.K. Rao of IFHE on NAAC preparedness of ICFAI University, Dehradun and suggested constituting an internal committee in line with IQAC structure to address the weaknesses noticed by Prof. Rao and prepare a road map with timeline for action with assigned responsibilities with VC, IUD as Chairman. The Board also noted the assurance given by Special Officer, IUD to bring down the list of weaknesses to less than 10 in next six months and suggested that the action taken on these points be put up to the Board in next Board meeting.	Internal Quality Assessment Cell (IQAC) has been constituted recently to monitor the preparedness of the University for NAAC Accreditation in the light of weaknesses already identified by Dr. TSRK Rao. The process of revamping the activities of the University in the recent period has helped overcome some of the weaknesses identified earlier. With the formal working of the IQAC, we hope to address rest of the weaknesses over time.
