

ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY

The ICFAI University, Dehradun, Uttarakhand (hereinafter referred to as the University) was established under the ICFAI University Act 2003 (Act No.16 of 2003) passed by the Uttaranchal Legislative Assembly and assented to by the Governor on July 08, 2003. Government Gazette, Uttaranchal.

The university is located at Selaqui in Dehradun district of Uttrakhand. The university has a campus area of 25 Acres. ICFAI University, Dehradun (IUD), and is comprises of four schools,, which are as ICFAI Law School (ILS), ICFAI Business School (IBS), ICFAI Tech School (ITS) and ICFAI Education School (IEd.S). The ICFAI University, Dehradun, Uttarakhand is sponsored by the Institute of Chartered Financial Analysts of India (ICFAI), a non-profit educational society established in 1984 under the Andhra Pradesh (Telangana Area) Public Societies Registration Act, 1350 F (Act No.1 of 1350F), with the objective of imparting training in finance and management to students, working executives and professionals in India.

The ICFAI University, Dehradun, Uttarakhand is included in the list of universities maintained by the University Grants Commission (UGC) under Section 2(f) of the UGC Act, 1956, vide their letter No. F.9-26/2003 (CPP-I) dated July 22, 2005. The Distance Education Council (DEC) has approved the programs of the ICFAI University, Dehradun.

The Bar Council of India has accorded its approval for imparting three year and five year Law Courses at ICFAI University, Dehradun, Uttarakhand and award degrees in law.

The University has received the approval of NCTE to offer the Bachelors Program in Education through the Faculty of Education. The ICFAI University, Uttarakhand is included in the approved institutions maintained by NCTE.

The University believes in creating and disseminating knowledge and skills in core and frontier areas through innovative educational programs, research, consulting and publishing, and developing a new cadre of professionals with a high level of competence and deep sense of ethics and commitment to the code of professional conduct.

A number of educational programs are offered in management, finance, banking, insurance, accounting, law, information technology, arts, commerce, education and science & technology at bachelor's and master's levels on full-time campus. The sprawling and verdant beauty of the campus, the striking and well maintained academic buildings, the engaging staff and student activities make the campus very vibrant. The academic programmes offered in the University have a distinct focus on Management, Law, Science & Technology and Humanities; reflecting the objective of the University. Currently the University is offering Doctor of Philosophy programmes (Ph.D.) in all disciplines of Management, Law, Education and Science & Technology. The ICFAI University has well developed number of state-of-the-art laboratories such as Robotics, Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning, Mechatronics, Red Hat, Texas Instrument Innovation Lab etc. It has computing facilities with internet connectivity of 100mbps, a dedicated power supply system and a rich library having connectivity to several digital libraries. Other basic amenities like central water supply, campus security, canteen, gymnasium, indoor & outdoor sports facilities with solar lights, are available on the campus to cater to the various needs of the university community.

The ICFAI University, Dehradun has emerged as one of the most sought after Universities in the North India. The University has a pan India look with students from all states taking admission here and the percentage of such students taking admissions in this University is on the rise. The University can rightly be proud of what it has achieved in the last 17 years since its inception. OBJECTIVES OF THE UNIVERSITY

The ICFAI University, Dehradun shall disseminate and advance knowledge by providing instructional and research facilities in such branches of learning as it may deem relevant and to make provisions for integrated courses in management, Law, Science & Technology, humanities, natural and physical sciences, social sciences and allied disciplines in the educational programmes of the University; to take appropriate measures for promoting innovations in teaching-learning processes, inter-disciplinary studies and research; to educate and train manpower for the development of the State of Uttarakhand; to pay special attention to the improvements of the social and economic conditions and welfare of the people of the State, their intellectual, academic and cultural development.

Action Plan

Administrative

- A manpower auditing will be undertaken to identify under -utilized academic and administrative staff. An IQAC cell has been set to look the existing manpower and need for new recruitments.
- Recruitment procedure will be strengthened and all new applicants will be required to present a research seminar at the department/university level for more effective and objective judgment. A contractual appointment will be offered in the first place at the entry level and only after satisfactory performance a candidate will be inducted in permanent cadre.
- Facilitate visits by international scholars.
- > Developing multi-skilled manpower.
- Periodic review of administration centrally to improve work online and developing a database of Students, Teaching & Non - Teaching staff.

Academic

Teaching and research in the inter-disciplinary areas will be promoted by introducing more interdisciplinary contents in the existing courses; starting new courses; establishing new centers and by encouraging interdisciplinary seminars/ conferences/ workshops as per the new National Education Policy

Technical

E - Connectivity

➤ The existing campus wide network will be extended and strengthened. The existing band width will be enhanced from 100 Mbps to 200 Mbps. The number of e- journals and e-books will be increased and e-access will also be offered to other Universities & College in Uttrakhand to put them at par with International Standards.

Finances

A new budgetary approach will be adopted and financial matters would be managed by professionals. Steps will be taken for facile management of grants received by the faculty for their project work.

Miscellaneous

- 19 Faculty Inviting eminent scholars as visiting professors for duration ranging from two months to a year.

- 3. To engage in research activities beneficial to society.

Strategy

The University will undertake the following research strategies to achieve the above targets:

- Faculty members with research excellence in the identified key areas of research will be recruited.
- 2. Faculty will be advised to have minimum of one research project at any point in time.
- 3. Policy for break from academics for a semester to focus on research will be framed.
- 4. Research activities will be aligned with approved thrust areas.
- 5. Two to four clusters of research on leading areas will be set up.
- 6. Interdisciplinary research will be promoted.
- 7. Top three research outcomes by faculty members will be hosted on the University website.
- 8. Innovative projects in B. Tech. and M. Tech. /Management levels will be emphasized.
- 9. Our research inventions will be commercialized with 50% profits to the research team members.
- 10. The expertise of the University for Consultancy Services will be publicized on university website. The earnings from consultancy by a faculty will be enhanced from the present amount.
- 11. All Schools will be required to have 1 or 2 consultancy services.
- 12. IPR Cell of the University comprising of faculty members & students will discuss with each School and identify processes/products for patenting. Such identified processes/products will be vigorously taken up.
- 13. More linkages & with government institutions, premiere national and international research laboratories, and industries will be established and maintained.
- 14. State of the art facilities and equipment will be provided.
- 15. E-resources will be provided to all faculties & students.
- 16. Research ethics and integrity of the highest order will be maintained.
- 17. Programmes for mentoring and supporting young faculties will be undertaken.
- 18. The right environment that attracts and retains faculty who are at the peak of their careers will be created.

- 12 It will work towards the grant receive for research project from the International Agencies UNO, UNESCO, Government of India & Central Agency.
- 13 The University aims at marketing its intellectual property.
- 14 It will conduct research which have social relevance and contribute to national development.
- 15 It aims at connecting with industries rather strongly and receives grants from them for industrial research.
- 16 Scholarships will be provided to economically disadvantaged students.
- 17 Our best practices and innovations that contribute to social well-being will be communicated to the society.
