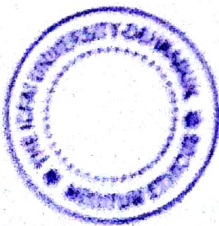
Dear Sir/Madam,

Workshop on Case Method at ICFAI University Dehradun



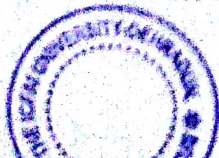
A three day workshop on Case Method for Management (IBS Dehradun) and Law faculty of ICFAI University, Dehradun, was conducted by Prof. G.V Muralidhar and Prof. D. Satish from Case Research Center, IBS Hyderabad, at the University campus.

Prof. Muralidhara explained how the case study method is a student centric approach to learning and discussed important issues of case based learning. Prof. Satish provided tips on preparing an effective analysis of a case.

Multiple case discussion sessions, facilitated by the participants, were held. Each participant was assigned a case to study thoroughly and was selected, on a random basis, to facilitate a case discussion on it.
