- The setting up of question papers should be designed as per the Blooms Taxonomy and the Learning outcomes for students are to be evaluated.

- The Performance indicators (that tells about what the concrete action students need to perform and the action work).
- On completion of the Course the students should have achieved a minimum level these outcomes, in respect to their development of Skills, Knowledge and Behavior.
- Evaluation describes the students' performance and pinpoints the areas they need to improve upon.
