1. Congratulating the members for ICFAI University, Dehradun being accredited by NAAC.

The Vice Chancellor-O Dr. Muddu Vinay congratulated the NAAC core committee members for the NAAC Accreditation of The ICFAI University, Dehradun. He said it is hard work and team cooperation of all to have achieved NAAC accreditation. He informed the members that IUD has made the qualifying grade 'C'. He thanked the NAAC Coordinator and the team members for their efforts and obtaining a CGPA of 1.78.

2. Action to be taken on recommendations given in the NAAC Report.

The Vice Chancellor-O Dr.Muddu Vinay recapitulated the NAAC journey covered and the work to be done in the next cycle to achieve 'A++' grade. He informed the members that the Peer Team Report, will be mailed to each School and departments by the IQAC coordinator to act upon the recommendations given in it and implement them at the earliest. IUD should now focus on the NAAC second cycle which is likely to take place in 2025.

3. Documentation and preparation for NAAC Improvement Criteria's.

The Vice Chancellor congratulated Mr. Amit Das for being instrumental in getting a grant of Rs. 1,60,000/- from Technical Education Quality Improvement Programme; MHRD fund. He also informed the members that Mr. Amit Das is in the process of getting Rs. 20,00,000/- from DRDO. These funds will be used for various research projects; thus every School should be prepared with their Research Projects proposals and improve upon their quality of research. He advised the members that since they now have NAAC experience; henceforth documentation for all activities of the respective Schools and departments is to be timely prepared and submitted to IQAC. The IQAC will collate and maintain the records accordingly. The Vice Chancellor briefed the members that many important events are lined up throughout 2020. The reports along with geo-tagged photographs are to be handed over to IQAC immediately after the conduct of the event.

4. Action to be taken on recommendations given in the NAAC Report.

The IQAC Coordinator, Maj.(Dr.) V.N Saxena, informed that quarterly, internal documentation audit will be held from now on so that each School and departmental records are maintained regularly.
